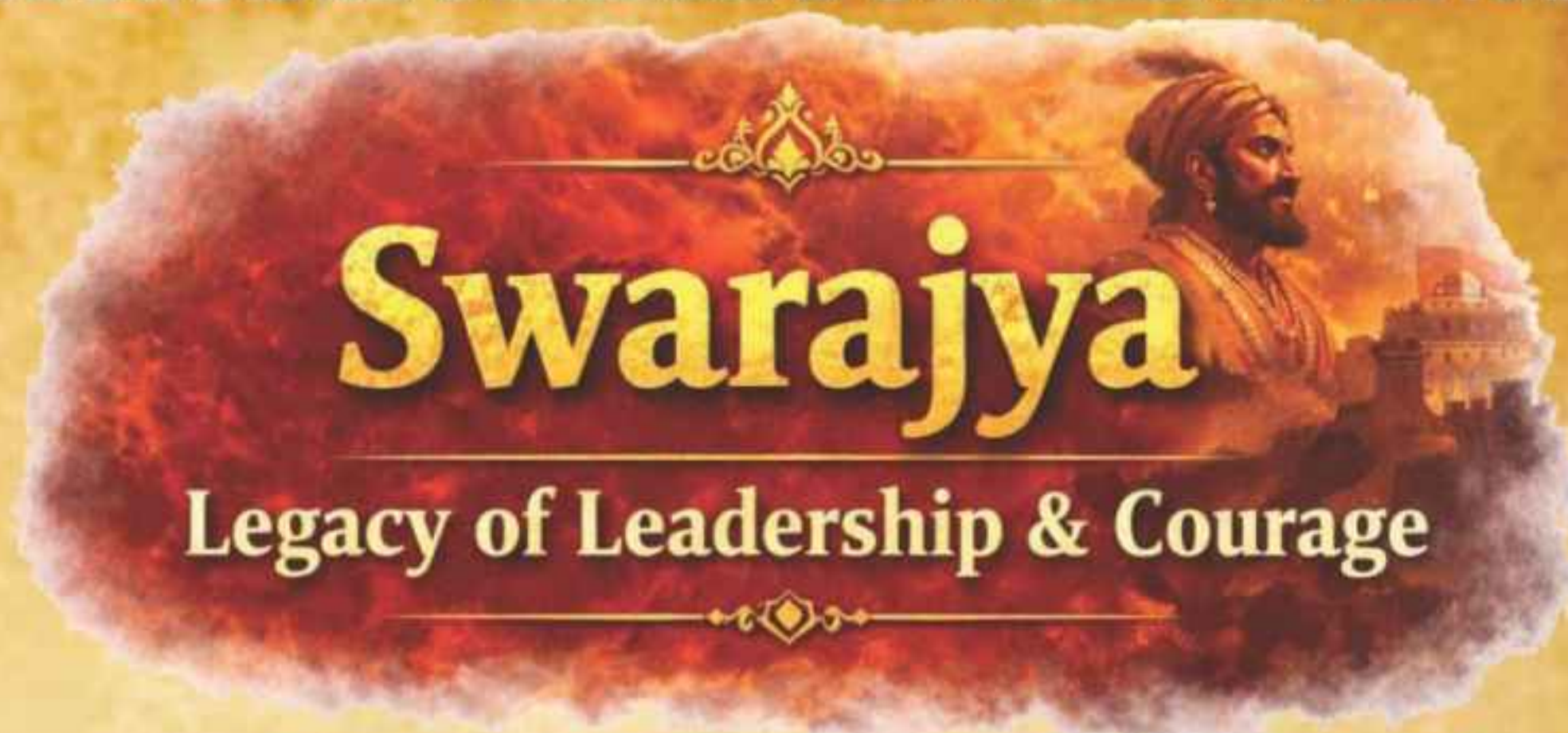

— GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS —

1. All participants must carry their valid college ID card.
2. Team should report at the venue for registration at 8.30 A.M.
3. Entry will be restricted after the event begins.
4. Registration once done cannot be changed or replaced.
5. Participants must compulsorily participate in all the events.
6. Participants must strictly follow the theme:
“**Swarajya - Legacy of Leadership & Courage**”
7. Any kind of misbehaviour, disrespect, or misconduct will lead to immediate disqualification.
8. Arguments with judges or organisers may lead to:
 - i. Disqualification of the participants.
 - ii. Disqualification of the entire team (if applicable)
9. Judges' decision will be final and binding.
10. Any damage to college property will be strictly penalized.
11. Participants must maintain discipline and decorum throughout the event.
12. Use of vulgar, offensive, or culturally disrespectful content is strictly prohibited.
13. Organising Committee holds full authority to modify or cancel any event if required.
14. All participating teams are required to pay a refundable registration fee of Rs. 1000/-. The amount will be refunded on the day of the event.
15. Only 15 registered participants per college are allowed. No external supporters or non-participants will be permitted.
16. Each College shall nominate one team only.
17. Participants are allowed to participate in more than one event, but the organising committee shall not be responsible for clash of events.

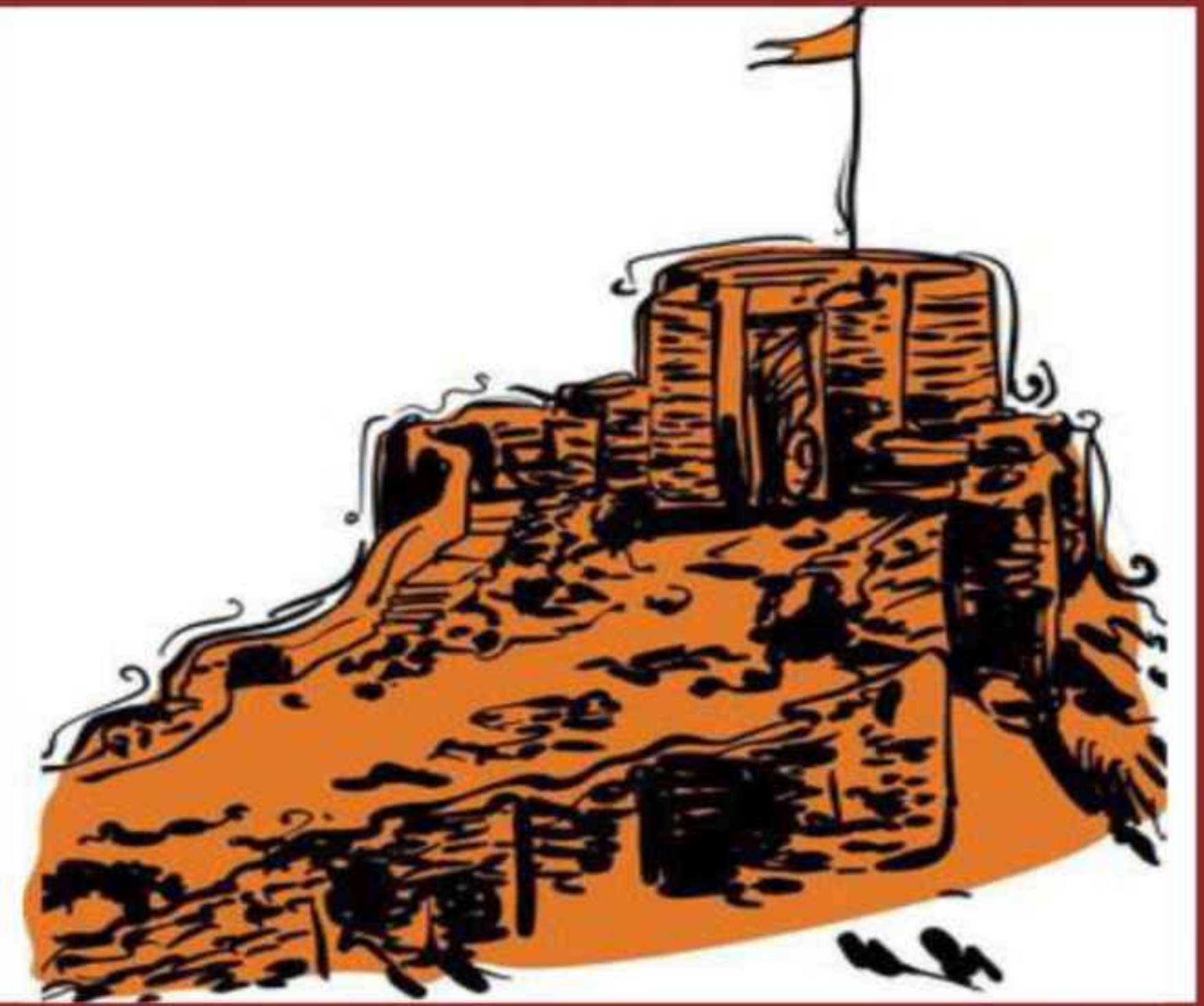

Venue: SVVM College Hall

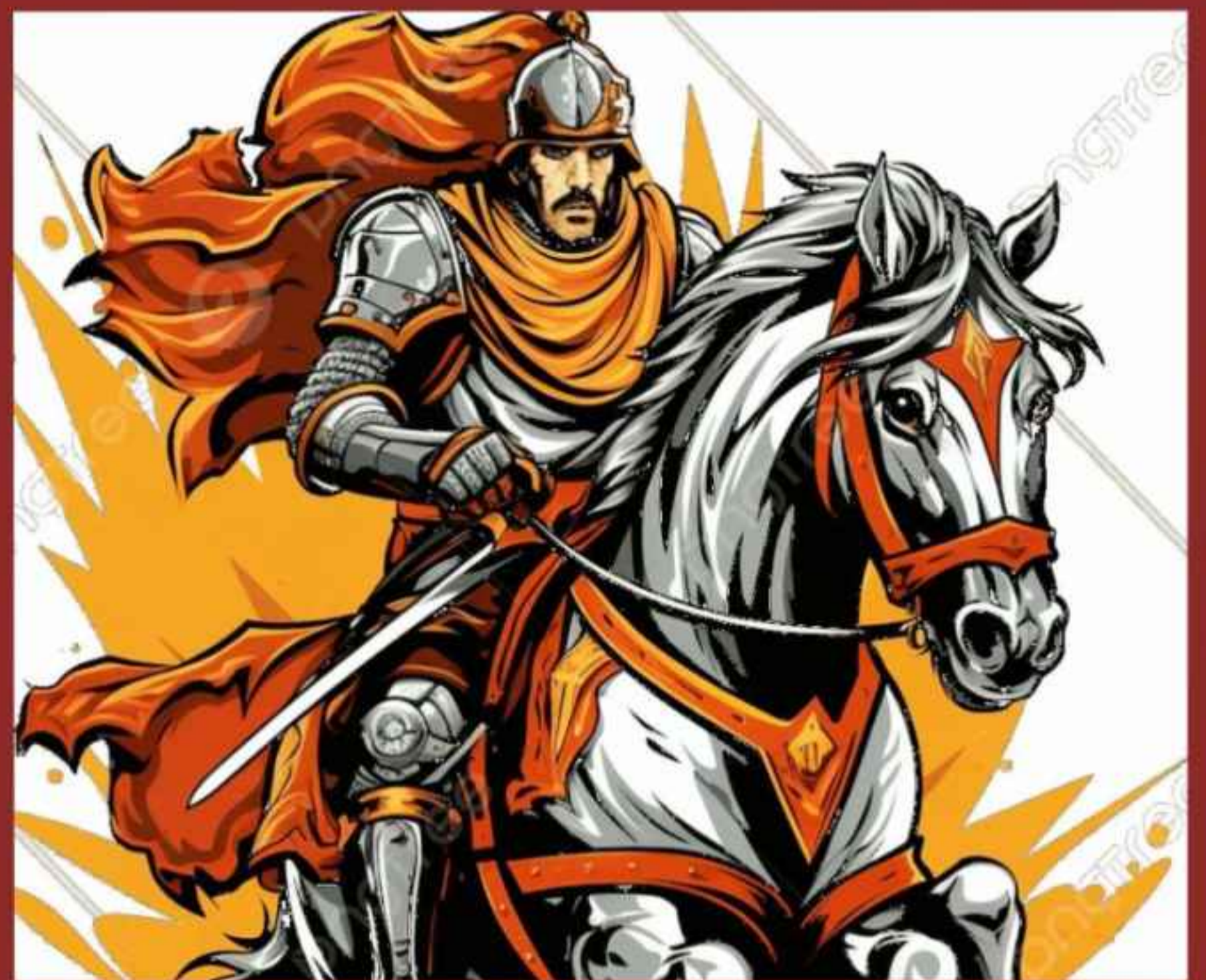
- ❖ Time limit: 4–6 minutes

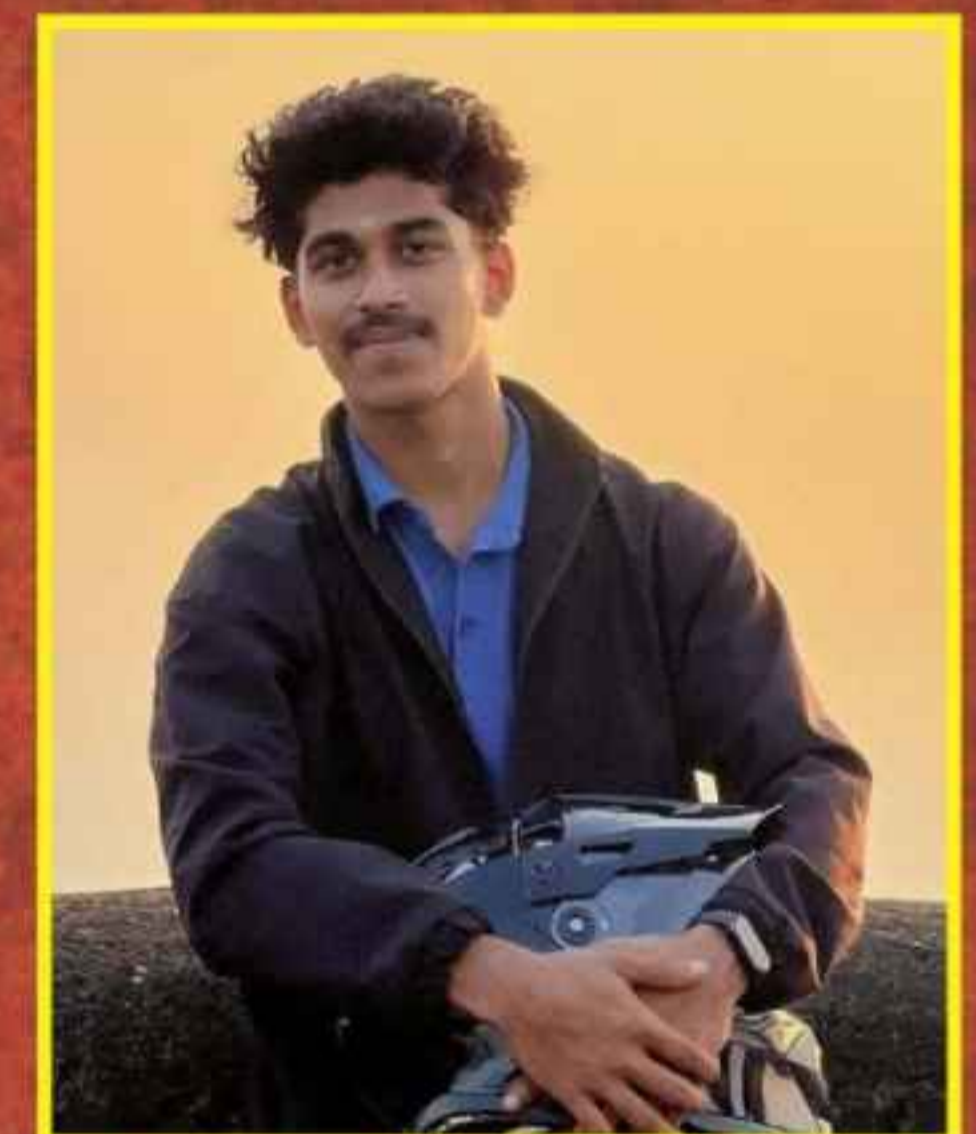

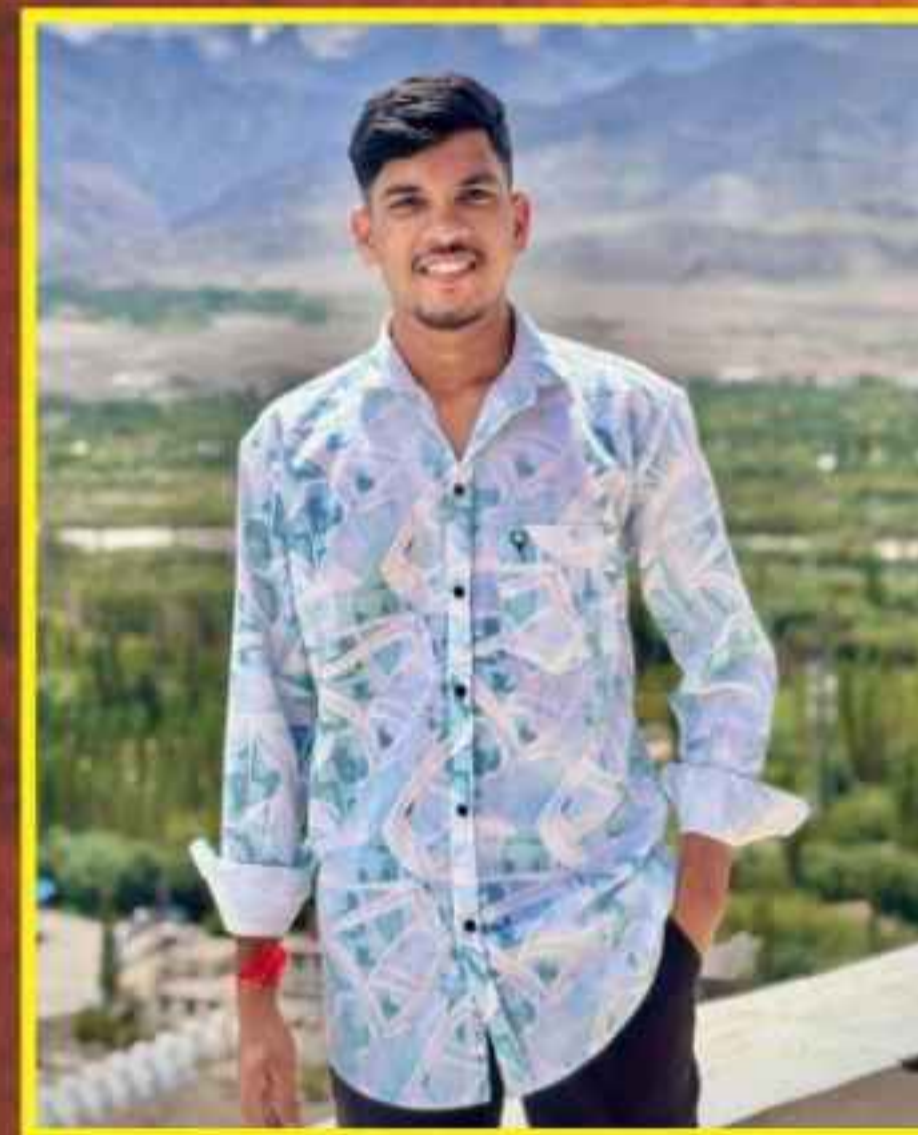
