The event saw participation from students, parents, staff and residents, with over 500 visitors attending. Around 1,200 books, including storybooks, novels and competitive exam material, were made available, all contributed by donors. Nearly 1,100 books were taken by visitors during the two days. Chief guest was a journalist with Tarun Bharat, Guruprasad Pai. Chairman of the Local Managing Committee of the Mandal, Minanath Upadhye, described it as a "unique festival" connecting book donors and readers.

Principal Professor Achut Pednekar said, "The right books will go to the right user at the right time."

The concept drew on the principles of library science pioneer Dr S. R. Ranganathan.

Librarian Sonia Desai said it was guided by his belief that readers should be able to find books that interest them and that every book should find its readers.

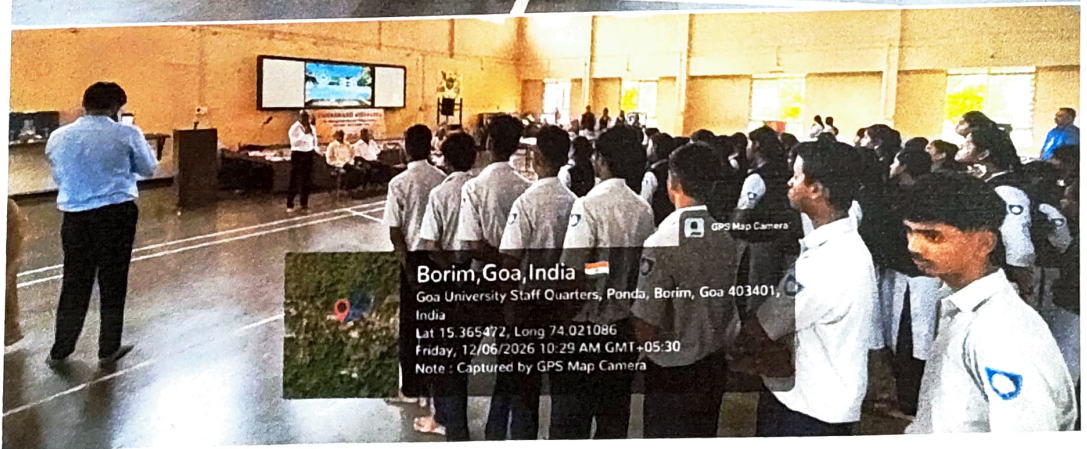

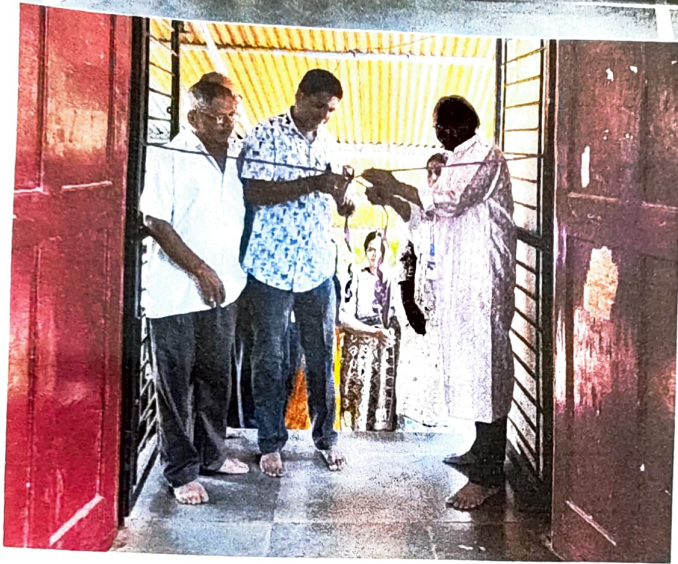
